

1. What is Lean Management?

Among Lean thinkers, the term Lean Management is a popular and famous word. Everybody knows this terminology. And, many know it as 5S, TPM, Value Stream Mapping, Kanban, 6 sigma, etc. But what is the true meaning of the word "lean"? The word "lean" was originally used to describe "lean meat" which meant meat that are low in fatty grease. The grease is actually waste. Lean management is about increasing your existing resources and reducing wastes.

No one likes waste. The common 7 types of wastes are:

- ✓ Transportation
- Inventory
- Motion
- Waiting
- ✓ Over-Production
- ✓ Over-Processing
- Defects

Why do we have to eliminate wastage? Because management must focus on shorter lead time. A shorter lead time will make significant impact on your financial numbers especially cash flow. If you allow the 7 types of waste in your business flow, you will be unable to create shorter lead times. These wastes will always increase lead time.

Another impactful topic that is similar to waste is Work-In-Progress or WIP. This build up is considered "stopping time" (sleeping time) in the process flow. How would you create faster material flow? The key is lean management. Comparing the profits between big lot sizes and small lot sizes, which has the shorter lead time? Without doubt, small lot sizes are always better than big lot sizes. The ideal target is one-piece-flow. If you establish a narrow and fast process flow, you can easily notice abnormalities about the process; and when this happens, you can perform problem solving activities. This is also a key action of Lean Management. A sense of urgency is important for managers. If you are a Managers, what is your responsibility? In my opinion, a manager's responsibility is how to save money for the company, every day. For this, you have to develop your visual management tools, which help you identify wastages in your process easily.




2. Why Lean Management is important for SMEs.

The number of SMEs worldwide is bigger than large companies. Many SME owners are thinking that lean management is not for them. Lean management is only for large corporate companies. If more SMEs could introduce lean management into their processes, the profits will immediately appear in the cash flow, and the company's performance will be better. Your profits can then be returned to your employees and society. If you want to do this, it is important to have strong leadership and team work. SMEs can easily change and adapt to introduce lean management. But it is harder for big companies to address the challenges of the lean management implementation. This is because when an organization is too big, there is strong resistance from middle managers.

3. What are the challenges a SME faces and how Lean Management can address those challenges.

First of all, you must understand the current condition of your production floor and material movement. Certain "Sensei's" can help make clear your condition by performing a Genba-Walk. The next step is the implementation of 2S (Seiri and Seiton) Do not attempt to perform all the 5S's at the beginning. Sort and Set-in-Order is enough. Your WIP will be removed from your production floor. As a result, you will gain more floor space. The following step is the flow processing line. You can try one-piece flow production. Please try implementing it together with your Finance Manager. The Finance Manager will help you to understand those numbers and see your profit.

How Train And Re-train First Aiders Contribute in Productivity

First Aid training at work place is a critical need, yet much neglected. It is an investment puzzling many decision makers because this investment couldn't assure them Return of Investment (ROI).

Then, why should we invest in first aid training and equipment? Because first aid contributes to productivity in many ways,

such as reduce non-productive absence.

First aid aims to preserve lives, prevent further injuries, as well as promote recovery. Appropriate first aid helps staff to return to duty sooner, with fewer complications. In another word, production back to normal sooner.

It is also important re-train your fellow colleagues.

Those renew one or more times generally performed better than those who have learned only once. This is particularly true because our colleagues do not practice first aid on regular basis. Regular re-training is important to retain knowledge and skills, as studies do show that emergency skills deteriorate as soon as 6 months.

Another reason to regularly re-train work place first aiders, is the rapid changing trend in medical developments. One good example is resuscitation experts meet every 5 years to come out with International Liaison Committee on Resuscitation (ILCOR) guidelines. And the latest ILCOR recommendation 2015 was released just less than 2 months ago.



First aid training is also beneficial to friends and family. All of us spent most of our time with people we care and love. If we are trained in first aid, the skill can be put to good use during emergencies.

Train and re-train our colleagues, this helps to ensure that we have a safe and productive working environment; and of course, filled with loving care for each other.


