There are many initiatives have been established and developed to reduce accident and injuries rates and studies have shown the Behavioural Based Safety Approach is the most significant methodology in making Zero Injuries achievable



Workplace Accident Prevention With BBS

Human behavior is influenced by the mind sets and actions performed by human beings depends on the thoughts, feelings, beliefs, values, priorities, including the need of a person.

The behavioural Based Safety is a approach to change the mindsets of human behavior in achieving Zero Injuries and behave in a Safe Behavior instead of At-Risk Behavior.

The Heinrich's Domino Theory state that Injury is caused by Accident that caused by Unsafe Act and Unsafe Condition, where all these are due to fault of person. This failure can be corrected with BBS approach.

Human Error Is The Answer For BBS

The analogy of accident has shown fault of person or human error the one cause of accident and injury issue such as complacency, fatigue and wrong way of performing or doing thing.


The human error is very much related to mindsets and behavior of a person who is performing task. The behavior is the outcome of a thinking process, feeling, belief, priority, value and needs of a person. Someone having less and no experience will not able to analyze the hazard exist while doing the critical task and thinking process does not capture any potential harm that may be caused.

Feeling of fear will make someone take reasonable care and ensure all relevant Personal Protective Equipment are worn before resume any hazardous task. A lab technician having fear of get harm will wear all the required PPE such as Respirator, Glove, Goggles & Apron when handle corrosive chemical.

Behavioural Based Safety is particulary related to self-managed and own choice of performing task safely instead of doing thing At-Risk Behavior.

A person belief system will influence its behavior such as if someone belief working in high noise are can cause hearing impairment than compliance of wearing ear plug or muff will beno compromising.

The Answer of The Importance of Safety



Where hazard of contact with hot surfaces exist than wearing a hand sleeve and heat resistant glove will be required and those putting the priority to safety will wear it except to those fail to comply as wanted to work comfortably as this is their top priority.

Having value to be safe in whatever activity involved will be seen through behavior of someone such as wearing cut resistant glove when deal with sharp items or working with knife.

Our need will determine our behavior and if popular and monetary is the most what we wanted than we wall scarify others especially out own safety.


