HOW SAFETY SHOES CAN PROTECT YOU

Importance of Wearing Safety Shoes

Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) is essential for workers with jobs that involve heavy apparatus, chemical fluids, inclement environment and fire hazards. Thus, below is a list of circumstances on how safety footwear can safeguard your feet from any unfortunate incidents:

Chemical exposure

Chemicals such as acids, solvents, vapors, fumes and flammable materials can cause a serious reaction when they come into contact with skin. Choosing a correct safety footwear with excellent resistance over common chemicals is crucial in keeping these substances out from your shoes.

Metal filings

If your job is to deal with glass, concrete, rocks, metal and any sharp objects, it is advisable for you to pick a safety footwear with a steel toe cap and steel midsole for penetration resistance in against cuts and piercing from any sharp objects.

Lethargy

There are jobs that require workers to stand for long hours that often led to fatigue and unproductive. To encounter this problem, it is imperative to wear a comfortable safety footwear with extra wide-fitting toe cap and outsole designed to offer extra comfort while maintaining the durability.

Temperature fluctuations

Jobs like mining and manufacturing sometimes can cause a serious burn if did not manage carefully due to high temperatures. An ideal safety footwear with outstanding heat resistance, excellent sweat absorption and steel toe cap would be the most suitable pick for this situation.

Slippery floors

Apart from temperature fluctuations, wet condition with slippery floors might cause a serious injury to workers for instance severe sprains and fractures due to slips and falls. A safety footwear with PU outsole to withstand unpleasant weather and offers outstanding slip resistance is a correct pick for this particular situation.

Long Soo Keat will meet them when more than 1,000 people gather to learn the skills that the boys used to save him – cardio pulmonary resuscitation (CPR) – and how to use an automated external defibrillator (AED).

On Sept 1, Long had a sudden cardiac arrest during a football match with his fellow Chung Ling High School alumni at the school field.

The five boys – St John Ambulance Malaysia (SJAM) L/Cpl Gabriel Soon Chai Long, 16, Pvt Liong Jun Yong, 16, 14-year-old cadets Ansley Tan Zhong, S. Shaman and Tang Yi Ze – were on duty and used CPR and the school's AED to get Long's heart to beat again after 12 minutes.
