SBL-KHAS SCHEME PROCEDURE FOR SAFETYWARE EHS CONSULTANCY SDN BHD

This training program is claimable under the SBL-KHAS Scheme. Safetyware will claim the course fee directly from the employer's account with HRD Corp. However, HRD Corp approval is required before the commencement of the program by submission via the eTRiS system under Skim Bantuan Latihan (SBL-KHAS). The company must make the FULL PAYMENT if no disbursement is received from HRD Corp (SBL-KHAS scheme) under any circumstances.

Procedures:

1. Pre-Training: Submission of Application via eTris

Employers must submit the training grant application for Safetyware EHS Consultancy Sdn Bhd's Safety 360 - EHS Conference 2024 via the eTRiS system prior to the start of the program.
